Regulations Affecting Small Businesses – Extensions for Compliance

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Business and Economic 4 Development, under certain circumstances, to grant an extension to certain 5 small businesses for compliance with regulations adopted by Executive Branch 6 agencies; requiring a small business, in order to be granted an extension, to 7 prepare a certain economic impact analysis and a certain plan for compliance 8 with the regulations; requiring the small business to submit certain documents 9 to the Department; requiring the Department to coordinate with the appropriate Executive Branch agency to make a certain determination; 10 requiring the Department to take certain actions based on a certain 11 12 determination; requiring the Department to provide certain notice to the small 13 business; authorizing a small business to comply with regulations in accordance with a certain plan under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to 14 publish certain information in the Maryland Register; requiring the 15 16 Department to maintain a certain database; requiring a small business to 17 comply with certain regulations during a certain period of time; defining a 18 certain term; and generally relating to regulations affecting small businesses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SMALL BUSINESS" MEANS A CORPORATION, 3 PARTNERSHIP, SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP, OR OTHER BUSINESS ENTITY, 4 INCLUDING ITS AFFILIATES, THAT:
- 5 (1) IS INDEPENDENTLY OWNED AND OPERATED;
- 6 (2) IS NOT DOMINANT IN ITS FIELD; AND
- 7 (3) EMPLOYS 100 OR FEWER FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES.
- 8 (B) SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION, A SMALL BUSINESS MAY BE GRANTED 9 AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY AN 10 EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCY UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE 11 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 12 (C) (1) IN ORDER TO BE GRANTED AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE
 13 WITH REGULATIONS UNDER THIS SECTION, THE SMALL BUSINESS SHALL
 14 PREPARE AN ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS AND A PLAN FOR COMPLIANCE IN
 15 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION.
 - (2) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS SHALL:
- 17 (I) ESTIMATE THE COST TO THE SMALL BUSINESS OF 18 COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS; AND
- 19 (II) SHOW THAT THE COST OF COMPLIANCE WILL EXCEED 20 THE GROSS REVENUE OF THE SMALL BUSINESS FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.

- 26 (D) THE SMALL BUSINESS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT:
- 27 (1) A REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE WITH 28 REGULATIONS IN THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT;
- 29 (2) THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS; AND

- 2 (E) (1) ON RECEIPT OF A REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION FOR
- 3 COMPLIANCE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COORDINATE
- 4 WITH THE APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCY THAT ADOPTED THE
- 5 REGULATIONS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE **D**EPARTMENT AGREES OR
- 6 DISAGREES WITH THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS AND PLAN FOR
- 7 COMPLIANCE SUBMITTED BY THE SMALL BUSINESS.
- 8 (2) IF THE DEPARTMENT AGREES WITH THE ECONOMIC IMPACT
- 9 ANALYSIS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE THE ECONOMIC IMPACT
- 10 ANALYSIS AND SHALL EITHER APPROVE OR MODIFY THE PLAN FOR
- 11 COMPLIANCE.
- 12 (3) IF THE DEPARTMENT DISAGREES WITH THE ECONOMIC
- 13 IMPACT ANALYSIS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISAPPROVE THE ECONOMIC
- 14 IMPACT ANALYSIS AND THE PLAN FOR COMPLIANCE.
- 15 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INDICATE ITS APPROVAL OR
- 16 DISAPPROVAL OF THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS AND APPROVAL,
- 17 MODIFICATION, OR DISAPPROVAL OF THE PLAN FOR COMPLIANCE BY A
- 18 WRITTEN STATEMENT TO THE SMALL BUSINESS.
- 19 **(F)** IF A SMALL BUSINESS IS GRANTED AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE
- 20 UNDER THIS SECTION, THE SMALL BUSINESS:
- 21 (1) MAY COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 22 THE PLAN FOR COMPLIANCE APPROVED OR MODIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT;
- 23 AND
- 24 (2) NEED NOT COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE
- 25 WITH THE REGULATIONS THEMSELVES DURING THE PERIOD THE EXTENSION
- 26 FOR COMPLIANCE IS IN EFFECT.
- 27 (G) FOR EACH SMALL BUSINESS GRANTED AN EXTENSION FOR
- 28 COMPLIANCE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH IN THE
- 29 MARYLAND REGISTER:
- 30 (1) THE NAME OF THE SMALL BUSINESS;
- 31 (2) THE PARTICULAR REGULATIONS AS TO WHICH THE SMALL
- 32 BUSINESS HAS BEEN GRANTED AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE; AND

- 1 (3) THE TIME FRAME WITHIN WHICH THE SMALL BUSINESS IS 2 REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS.
- (H) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAINTAIN A DATABASE THAT INCLUDES, FOR EACH SMALL BUSINESS GRANTED AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE INFORMATION ABOUT THE SMALL BUSINESS PUBLISHED IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION.
- 8 (2) THE DATABASE SHALL BE REASONABLY AVAILABLE FOR 9 PUBLIC INSPECTION.
- 10 (I) DURING THE PERIOD OF TIME THE DEPARTMENT IS CONSIDERING A
 11 REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE
 12 SMALL BUSINESS SHALL CONTINUE TO COMPLY WITH THE PARTICULAR
 13 REGULATIONS AS TO WHICH IT IS SEEKING AN EXTENSION FOR COMPLIANCE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
