- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Aviation Administration to require that a 5 person serving as a transportation security officer, passenger screener, or 6 luggage screener at an airport in the State be certified by the Secretary of State 7 Police as having received certain training in the proper protocol for searching 8 and luggage in a constitutional manner; requiring the 9 Administration to require that a passenger's luggage may be searched only by a person having a certain certification and in the presence of the passenger; and 10 generally relating to airport security. 11
