## 1 AN ACT concerning

# Exposure to Organophosphate Pesticide – Time Limits for Bringing Civil Actions

the application of this Act; making clarifying and stylistic changes; and
generally relating to certain time limits for bringing certain civil actions

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

22 **3–904**.



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1 (g) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) **OR (3)** of this subsection, an 2 action under this subtitle shall be filed within three years after the death of the 3 injured person.

4 (2) (i) In this paragraph, "occupational disease" means a disease 5 caused by exposure to any toxic substance in the person's workplace and contracted by 6 a person in the course of the person's employment.

7 (II) THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ACTION
8 UNDER THIS SECTION ARISING FROM EXPOSURE TO AN ORGANOPHOSPHATE
9 PESTICIDE.

10 [(ii)] (III) If an occupational disease was a cause of a person's 11 death, an action UNDER THIS SECTION shall be filed WITHIN THE EARLIER OF:

12 1. [Within 10] **TEN** years of the [time] **DATE** of death; 13 or

14 2. [Within 3] THREE years of the date when the cause of
15 death was discovered[, whichever is the shorter].

16 (3) IF EXPOSURE TO AN ORGANOPHOSPHATE PESTICIDE WAS A 17 CAUSE OF A PERSON'S DEATH, AN ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE 18 FILED WITHIN THE LATER OF:

19(I)TWENTY YEARS FROM THE DATE OF EXPOSURE TO THE20ORGANOPHOSPHATE PESTICIDE; OR

21 (II) THREE YEARS OF THE DATE WHEN THE CAUSE OF 22 DEATH WAS DISCOVERED.

24 (b) (1) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ACTION FOR 25 PERSONAL INJURY ARISING FROM EXPOSURE TO AN ORGANOPHOSPHATE 26 PESTICIDE.

(2) (2) An action for damages arising out of an occupational disease shall be filed within 3 years of the discovery of facts from which it was known or reasonably should have been known that an occupational disease was the proximate cause of death, but in any event not later than 10 years from the date of death.

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1 IF EXPOSURE TO AN ORGANOPHOSPHATE PESTICIDE WAS A CAUSE OF 2 INJURY TO A PERSON, AN ACTION FOR PERSONAL INJURY SHALL BE FILED 3 WITHIN THE LATER OF:

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### (1) TWENTY YEARS FROM THE DATE OF EXPOSURE; OR

5 (2) THREE YEARS OF THE DATE WHEN THE CAUSE OF INJURY WAS
6 DISCOVERED.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 8 construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any 9 action that is not barred before June 1, 2012, by application of any time condition or 10 limit, but may not revive any action that was barred by application of any time 11 condition or limit before October 1, 2012.

12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 June 1, 2012.
