- 6 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Howard County Department of Inspections, 7 Licenses and Permits to request from the Criminal Justice Information System 8 Central Repository a State and national criminal history records check for an 9 applicant for a massage establishment license, pawnbroker or secondhand 10 dealer establishment license, taxicab license, or renewal of a massage 11 establishment license, pawnbroker or secondhand dealer establishment license, 12 or taxicab license; requiring that the department submit certain sets of fingerprints and fees to the Central Repository as part of the application for a 13 criminal history records check; requiring the Central Repository to forward to 14 15 the applicant and the department the applicant's criminal history record 16 information under certain circumstances; establishing that information 17 obtained from the Central Repository under this Act is confidential, may not be disseminated, and may be used only for certain purposes; authorizing a subject 18 of a criminal history records check under this Act to contest the contents of a 19 20 certain printed statement issued by the Central Repository; authorizing the 21 governing body of Howard County to adopt guidelines to carry out this Act; 22 defining certain terms; and generally relating to criminal history records checks 23 in Howard County.

10 11 12	(a) The County Administrator of Howard County shall apply to the Central Repository for a State and national criminal history records check for each prospective employee of Howard County.
13 14	(b) As part of the application for a criminal history records check, the Administrator of Howard County shall submit to the Central Repository:
15 16 17	(1) two complete sets of the prospective employee's legible fingerprints taken on forms approved by the Director of the Central Repository and the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation;

20 21	(3) the mandatory processing fee required by the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history records check.

 3 LICENSES AND PERMITS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY:
- 4 (I) TWO COMPLETE SETS OF THE APPLICANT'S LEGIBLE 5 FINGERPRINTS TAKEN ON FORMS APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE 6 CENTRAL REPOSITORY AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF 7 INVESTIGATION;
