2 Alcoholic Beverages – Rectifiers – Tours, Samples, and Sales

- FOR the purpose of expanding the privileges of a rectifying license so that the holder of the license may conduct guided tours of the licensed premises, serve not more than a certain number of samples of products manufactured at the licensed premises, sell certain foods and beverages, sell products manufactured on the licensed premises for consumption off the licensed premises, and sell related merchandise; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to rectifying licenses.
