#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Harford County - Slot Machines - Ownership and Operation by Eligible War Veterans' Organizations

FOR the purpose of authorizing eligible war veterans' organizations in Harford County
to own or operate slot machines under certain circumstances; altering the
definition of "eligible organization" to include a war veterans' organization that
has been located in Harford County for a certain number of years before the
organization applies for a license for a slot machine; and generally relating to
slot machine ownership and operation by eligible war veterans' organizations in
Harford County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (e) (1)(i) The State Comptroller shall regulate the operation of slot  $\mathbf{2}$ machines under this section. 3 (ii) The State Comptroller may adopt regulations to implement 4 the requirements of this section, including requiring audits of the annual reports  $\mathbf{5}$ submitted to the State Comptroller under subsection (c)(2)(viii) of this section. 6 Before an eligible organization may operate a slot machine under (2)7this section, the eligible organization shall obtain a license for the slot machine from 8 the State Comptroller. 9 (3)(i) The State Comptroller shall: 10 1. charge an annual fee for each license for a machine; 11 and 122.issue a license sticker to the applicant. 13The applicant shall place the sticker on the slot machine. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31October 1, 2012.
