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## Natural Resources - Hunting Licenses and Stamps

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying the uses of the State Wildlife and Management 4 Protection Fund; repealing obsolete language; clarifying that a certain 5 nonresident license does not authorize bear hunting; altering the fees for 6 certain hunting stamps and licenses; establishing a nonresident Maryland 7 migratory game bird stamp and certain turkey stamps; repealing a certain 8 requirement that the Department of Natural Resources use certain funds for a 9 certain purpose; repealing certain nonresident trapping restrictions; altering 10 the fee for a certain trapping license; establishing certain consolidated hunting 11 licenses and stamps; making certain technical corrections; providing for a delayed effective date for certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to 12 13 hunting licenses and stamps.

This license enables the purchaser to hunt migratory game birds only with the purchase of a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and to hunt wild waterfowl only with the purchase of both a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. This license enables the purchaser to hunt deer during bow and arrow season and black powder season only with the purchase of a nonresident bow and arrow or black powder stamp.

- 11 (3) An individual who purchases a bonus antlered deer stamp but does 12 not use it during a particular season may use that stamp during any subsequent 13 season in that hunting license year.
- 14 (4) The fee for each bonus antlered deer stamp issued in accordance 15 with this subsection shall be \$10.00 for residents and \$25.00 for nonresidents.
- 16 (5) The Department may establish by regulation the type and number 17 of deer stamps issued under this subsection if necessary to control the deer harvest in 18 various areas of the State.

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- (e) A person may not remove the head or hide or any part from any deer, except internal organs, or cut the meat into parts until the deer has been checked by the Department or 1 of the Department's agents at a designated checking station. Removal of the head or the hide of any deer not checked at a designated checking station shall be prima facie evidence that the deer was hunted illegally. Each separate deer or part of any deer taken illegally or found in possession shall be considered a separate offense.
- (f) Any person who, while operating a motor vehicle on any highway in the State, accidentally strikes and kills a deer on the highway may have the deer if the person produces visible evidence of collision with the deer to any Natural Resources police officer, State law enforcement officer, or other designated representative of the Secretary. The provisions of this subsection shall be applicable to deer killed by collision with a motor vehicle at any time whether during the open season for killing deer or during the legally closed season.
- (g) A person may not hunt a deer while the deer is taking refuge in or swimming through the waters of the State.
