A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010 – Prince George’s County**
3 **– Prince George’s VFD**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010
5 to change the name of a certain grantee from Prince George’s VFD to the Prince
6 George’s County Fire Department; adding the Marlboro Volunteer Fire
7 Department, the Beltsville Volunteer Fire Department, the Hyattsville
8 Volunteer Fire Department, the Kentland Volunteer Fire Department, and the
9 Laurel Volunteer Fire Department as grantees to a certain grant; making this
10 Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to amending the Maryland
11 Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010.

12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
13 Chapter 483 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2010
14 Section 1(3) Item ZA03(BE)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Chapter 483 of the Acts of 2010**

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That:

20 (3) ZA03 LOCAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES INITIATIVES

21 (BE) Prince George’s [VFD] COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT.
22 Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the
23 amount of the matching fund provided, to the Prince George’s

1 County [VFD] FIRE DEPARTMENT, THE MARLBORO
 2 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, THE BELTSVILLE

 4 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, THE KENTLAND
 5 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND THE LAUREL
 6 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT for the repair and
 7 renovation of the Prince George’s County [VFD] FIRE
 8 DEPARTMENT, located in Prince George’s County.
 9 Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund
 10 may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
 11 expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Prince
 12 George’s County) 250,000

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
 14 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
 15 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
 16 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
 17 the date it is enacted.
