## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Elevator Safety Review Board – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Elevator Safety Review Board to  
4 add a member representing the elevator interior renovation industry and a  
5 member who is an accessibility contractor; and generally relating to the  
6 membership of the Elevator Safety Review Board.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article – Public Safety  
9 Section 12–820(a)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2003 Volume and 2011 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Safety**

15 12–820.

16 (a) (1) The Board consists of the following **[nine] ELEVEN** members:

17 (i) as an ex officio member, the Commissioner; and

18 (ii) **[eight] TEN** members appointed by the Governor with the  
19 advice of the Secretary and with the advice and consent of the Senate.

20 (2) Of the **[eight] TEN** appointed members of the Board:

1 (i) one shall represent a major elevator manufacturing  
2 company or its authorized representative;

3 (ii) one shall represent an elevator servicing company;

4 (iii) one shall represent the architectural design profession;

5 (iv) one shall represent a municipal corporation in the State;

6 (v) one shall represent a building owner or manager;

7 (vi) one shall represent labor involved in the installation,  
8 maintenance, and repair of elevators; [and]

9 (VII) ONE SHALL REPRESENT THE ELEVATOR INTERIOR  
10 RENOVATION INDUSTRY;

11 (VIII) ONE SHALL BE AN ACCESSIBILITY CONTRACTOR; AND

12 [(vii)] (IX) two shall be members of the public.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
14 October 1, 2012.
