## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Vehicle Laws - Historic Motor Vehicles - Truck Tractors

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "historic motor vehicle" to include a truck tractor that meets certain requirements; and generally relating to the registration of historic motor vehicles.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

11-172.
"Truck tractor" means the noncargo carrying power unit that operates in combination with a semitrailer or trailer, except that a truck tractor and semitrailer engaged in the transportation of automobiles or boats may transport motor vehicles or boats on part of the power unit.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. 13-936.
(a) In this section, "historic motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle, including a passenger vehicle, motorcycle, [or] truck, OR TRUCK TRACTOR that:
(1) Is at least 20 years old;
(2) Has not been substantially altered from the manufacturer's original design; and
(3) Meets criteria contained in regulations adopted by the Administration.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
