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## Vehicle Laws – Historic Motor Vehicles – <del>Truck Tractors</del> <u>Trucks, Tractors,</u> and Motor Homes

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "historic motor vehicle" to include a truck 4 5 tractor that meets certain requirements establishing a certain historic motor 6 vehicle registration for certain trucks, tractors, and motor homes; establishing 7 certain qualifications for a historic motor vehicle registration under this Act; 8 establishing certain registration fees; prohibiting a vehicle registered under this 9 Act from being used in a certain manner; requiring a certain owner applying for 10 registration of a vehicle under this Act to certify that the vehicle will be maintained only for certain purposes; requiring the Motor Vehicle 11 12 Administration to issue certain registration plates under certain circumstances; providing that the presence of certain equipment is not required for the 13 operation of a vehicle registered under this Act; exempting a vehicle registered 14 under this Act from certain vehicle inspections; clarifying that this Act does not 15 limit the authority of a police officer to issue a certain safety equipment repair 16 17 order; prohibiting the transfer to a subsequent owner of a registration issued 18 under this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the 19 registration of historic motor vehicles.
