2 **State Government – Commemorative Month – German–American Heritage**
3 **Month**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to proclaim a certain month each year as
5 German–American Heritage Month; requiring the proclamation to urge certain
6 organizations to observe the month with certain activities; and generally
7 relating to German–American Heritage Month.

8 BY adding to
9 Article – State Government
10 Section 13–504
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Government**

16 **13–504.**

17 **(A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT GERMAN**
18 **AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM THE**
19 **MONTH OF OCTOBER EACH YEAR AS GERMAN–AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH.**

1 **(B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL**
2 **ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE GERMAN-AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH**
3 **PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 July 1, 2012.
