14 IN RECOGNITION OF THE LIVES OF THE STATE'S CITIZENS WHO HAVE 15 REACHED THE LANDMARK AGE OF 100 YEARS, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY 16 SHALL PROCLAIM THE SECOND THURSDAY IN MAY AS MARYLAND 17 CENTENARIANS DAY.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 19 October 1, 2012.
