A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Real Property – Recordation – Foreclosure Sales**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain purchaser in a foreclosure sale to pay the
4 entire amount of any required recordation or transfer taxes; requiring a certain
5 person to record a deed or final order of ratification within a certain period of
6 time after the entry of a final order ratifying a foreclosure sale; establishing a
7 certain penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to recordation
8 requirements and foreclosure sales.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Real Property**

17 **3–101.1.**

18 **IF THE SECURED PARTY IS THE PURCHASER AT A FORECLOSURE SALE**
19 **UNDER TITLE 7, SUBTITLE 1 OF THIS ARTICLE OF PROPERTY SUBJECT TO A**
20 **MORTGAGE OR DEED OF TRUST, AT THE TIME OF RECORDING A DEED**
21 **TRANSFERRING TITLE TO THE FORECLOSED PROPERTY TO THE SECURED**
22 **PARTY, THE SECURED PARTY SHALL PAY THE ENTIRE AMOUNT OF ANY**
23 **REQUIRED RECORDATION OR TRANSFER TAXES.**

1 **(A) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE ENTRY OF A FINAL ORDER RATIFYING A**
2 **SALE IN AN ACTION TO FORECLOSE A MORTGAGE OR DEED OF TRUST, THE**
3 **PERSON AUTHORIZED TO MAKE THE SALE SHALL:**

4 **(1) RECORD A DEED TRANSFERRING TITLE TO THE PROPERTY TO**
5 **THE PURCHASER; OR**

6 **(2) IF TITLE HAS NOT BEEN TRANSFERRED, RECORD THE FINAL**
7 **ORDER OF RATIFICATION.**

8 **(B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A**
9 **MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING**
10 **\$5,000.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2012.
