Motor Vehicles – Eligibility for Driver's License Test

- 3 FOR the purpose of reducing the period of time that certain individuals at least a 4 certain age who hold a learner's instructional permit are required to wait before $\mathbf{5}$ taking certain examinations for a provisional driver's license under certain 6 circumstances; reducing the driving practice requirements that an individual at 7 least a certain age is required to meet before taking certain examinations for a 8 provisional driver's license; establishing certain additional requirements related 9 to driver training for an individual who does not pass certain examinations for a 10 provisional driver's license after making a certain number of attempts; expanding the authority of the Motor Vehicle Administration to renew a driver's 11 12 license without requiring a driving test by authorizing renewal for an applicant who held a valid driving privilege within a certain period of time; making 13stylistic and conforming changes; and generally relating to eligibility for driver's 14 15license tests.
