17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "CONSUMER CONTRACT" MEANS A CONTRACT 18 INVOLVING "CONSUMER CREDIT", "CONSUMER DEBTS", "CONSUMER GOODS", 19 "CONSUMER REALTY", OR "CONSUMER SERVICES", AS DEFINED IN § 13–101 OF 20 THIS ARTICLE.

(B) A CONSUMER CONTRACT MAY CONTAIN A PROVISION FOR THE
PAYMENT OF LEGAL FEES BY THE LOSING PARTY IN A LEGAL ACTION INVOLVING
THE PARTIES TO THE CONSUMER CONTRACT ONLY IF THE PROVISION IS
EQUALLY APPLICABLE TO BOTH PARTIES TO THE CONSUMER CONTRACT.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 2 consumer contracts entered into on or after the effective date of this Act.
