19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23	(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.



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- 1 "Local performance standards" means standards for student and **(2)** 2 school performance developed by a county board. 3 (3)"Plan" means a comprehensive master plan. 4 "State performance standards" means standards for student and **(4)** 5 school performance approved by the State Board. 6 "Update" means an annual update to a county (5)board's 7 comprehensive master plan. 8 (b) (1) Each county board shall develop and implement a comprehensive 9 master plan that describes the goals, objectives, and strategies that will be used to improve student achievement and meet State performance standards and local 10 performance standards in each segment of the student population. 11 12 **(2)** Each county board shall submit a plan to the Department on (i) 13 or before October 1, 2003. 14 (ii) Each county board shall submit an update to the plan required under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph for review and approval by the 15 State Superintendent of Schools on or before: 16 17 1. October 15, [2008] **2012**; 2.October 15, [2009] **2013**; AND 18 October 15, [2010; and 19 3. 20 4. October 15, 2011] **2014**. 21On or before October 15, [2012] 2015, each county board (3)22shall submit a plan to the Department. 23 Beginning in [2013] **2016**, each county board shall submit (ii) 24an annual update for review and approval by the State Superintendent of Schools on 25 or before October 15 of each year. 26 Subject to subsection (i) of this section, the plan and updates **(4)** 27required under paragraph (3) of this subsection shall cover a 5-year period. 28 At least 30 days before submitting a plan or update to the

Department, a county board shall provide a copy of the proposed plan or update, with

2 3	(5) Each county board shall submit with the update required under paragraph (3)(ii) of this subsection:
$4\\5\\6$	(i) A detailed summary of how the board's current year approved budget and increases in expenditures over the prior year are consistent with the master plan; and
7 8	(ii) A summary of how the board's actual prior year budget and additional expenditures in the prior year's budget aligned with the master plan.
9 10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, $2012$ .
