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Agriculture - Commercial Feed - Arsenic Prohibition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using, selling, or distributing certain commercial feed that contains roxarsone or any other additive that contains arsenic; authorizing a person to use, sell, or distribute certain commercial feed that contains histostat; providing for the termination of this Act under certain circumstances; requiring the State Department of Agriculture to provide a certain notification; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the contents of commercial feed.
