### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Property Tax Assessment Appeals – Comparable Properties – Internet Access to Worksheets

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Assessments and Taxation to  $\mathbf{5}$ maintain a database, available to the public on the Department's Web site, of 6 certain information on any property that may be used as a comparable during 7 certain property tax assessment appeals; repealing an authorization for the 8 Department to charge a certain fee for certain information; and generally 9 relating to information regarding comparable properties for property tax assessment appeals provided by the State Department of Assessments and 10 Taxation. 11

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

person making the appeal may submit a written request to the supervisor, at least 15
days before the hearing, for a list of other properties that will be used as comparables
by the supervisor at the scheduled hearing.
