FOR the purpose of providing that certain retirees of the Correctional Officers' 4 Retirement System are subject to a certain offset of a retirement allowance $\mathbf{5}$ 6 under certain circumstances; clarifying the circumstances under which certain 7 retirees of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System are subject to a certain offset of a retirement allowance; altering the number of years required after 8 9 retirement for certain retirees of the State Retirement and Pension System to 10 be exempt from a certain earnings offset of their retirement allowance when 11 reemployed by certain employers; providing for the effective date of certain 12 provisions of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this 13Act; and generally relating to the reemployment of retirees in the State Retirement and Pension System. 14
