- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing certain students to participate in certain interscholastic 4 athletic activities of other schools in Talbot County under certain 5 circumstances; requiring a student to transfer to a certain school under certain 6 circumstances; providing that a student's participation in a certain 7 interscholastic athletic activity at other schools may require the schools' change 8 of certain classifications; requiring a certain school to change a certain 9 classification under certain circumstances; requiring certain parents or 10 guardians of certain students to provide transportation under certain circumstances to other schools in Talbot County at the expense of the parents or 11 guardians; prohibiting the Talbot County Board of Education from being 12 required to pay for or provide certain transportation for certain students; and 13 generally relating to participation in high school athletic programs. 14

 31 REGULATIONS AND POLICIES OF THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SECONDARY
 32 SCHOOLS ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, THE SCHOOL SHALL BE REQUIRED TO
 33 CHANGE ITS CLASSIFICATION.
