1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Personnel – Traumatic Events – Mental Health Support Services

FOR the purpose of requiring a certain unit of State government to make available
mental health support services to certain individuals affected by a traumatic
event that occurs in a facility of the unit and results in the death of an
individual; requiring certain mental health support services to be made
available to certain employees for a certain purpose and within a certain period
of time; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the provision of
mental health support services by units of State government.

21 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "UNIT" MEANS A UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE 22 BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

1 (B) A UNIT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT 2 SERVICES TO ANY EMPLOYEE OR OTHER INDIVIDUAL AFFECTED BY A 3 TRAUMATIC EVENT THAT OCCURS IN A FACILITY OF THE UNIT AND RESULTS IN 4 THE DEATH OF AN INDIVIDUAL.

5 (C) THE MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THIS 6 SECTION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE:

7 (1) TO AN EMPLOYEE TO ENSURE THAT THE EMPLOYEE HAS THE
8 MENTAL ABILITY TO RESUME THE EMPLOYEE'S DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES;
9 AND

10 (2) WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER THE TRAUMATIC EVENT OCCURS.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2012.
