1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 – Anne Arundel County – Benson–Hammond House

County Historical Society, Inc. provide a certain matching fund; requiring the
Board of Public Works to expend or encumber a certain grant by a certain date;

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 16 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, 17 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 18 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from 19 the date it is enacted.
