Election Law - Subsequent Election Absentee Ballot List

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Elections to establish guidelines for a 4 subsequent election absentee ballot list; requiring that a voter who receives an 5 absentee ballot be provided the opportunity to request an absentee ballot for the 6 next subsequent election in certain materials accompanying the absentee ballot; 7 requiring that a voter who requests an absentee ballot for the next subsequent election be placed on the subsequent election absentee ballot list; requiring that 8 9 an absentee ballot be sent to a voter on the subsequent election absentee ballot 10 list for certain elections; requiring that a voter be removed from the subsequent 11 election absentee ballot list under certain circumstances; requiring a voter who 12 requests an absentee ballot for the next subsequent election to notify the local board with certain information under certain circumstances; and generally 13 relating to the subsequent election absentee ballot list. 14

 24 TO WHICH THE VOTER'S PREVIOUS ABSENTEE BALLOT WAS SENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
