## Higher Education - Volunteer Firefighters Scholarship

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Volunteer Firefighters Scholarship; establishing 4 certain eligibility requirements for a scholarship; authorizing the use of a 5 scholarship for certain educational expenses; prohibiting the annual amount of 6 a scholarship from exceeding a certain percentage of the equivalent tuition and 7 certain fees of a certain institution of higher education; requiring a scholarship 8 recipient to maintain a certain grade point average; providing for the duration 9 of the scholarship; requiring scholarship recipients to file for certain federal and 10 State financial aid by a certain date; authorizing legislative scholarship funds to be used for certain purposes; providing that funds for the scholarship are as 11 12 provided in a certain annual budget by the Governor; establishing a Volunteer 13 Firefighters Scholarship Fund in the Higher Education Commission; directing 14 the Commission to use certain gifts and grants for the Fund in a certain manner; requiring the Commission to prepare a certain annual report regarding 15 16 the Fund; and generally relating to the establishment of the Volunteer Firefighters Scholarship. 17

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 (A) THERE IS A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS SCHOLARSHIP.
- 3 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY APPLY TO THE OFFICE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP 4 UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- 5 (1) IS A RESIDENT OF MARYLAND;
- 6 (2) (I) IS ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION OR ENROLLED IN THE 7 REGULAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION; OR
- 8 (II) IS ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION OR ENROLLED IN A
- 9 2-YEAR TERMINAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN WHICH THE COURSE WORK IS
- 10 ACCEPTABLE FOR TRANSFER CREDIT FOR AN ACCREDITED BACCALAUREATE
- 11 PROGRAM IN AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION; AND

- 1 (F) A SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT SHALL FILE FOR FEDERAL AND STATE 2 FINANCIAL AID BY MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR.

- 19 3. SHALL DEPOSIT ANY GIFT OR GRANT THAT IT

- 22 (3) (I) AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, THE COMMISSION

- 24 SCHOLARSHIP FUND THAT INCLUDES AN ACCOUNTING OF ALL FINANCIAL
