A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages – Distilleries – Tours, Samples, and Sales**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the privileges of a distillery license so that the holder of
4 the license may conduct guided tours of the licensed premises, serve not more
5 than a certain number of samples of products manufactured at the licensed
6 premises, sell certain foods and beverages, sell products manufactured on the
7 licensed premises for consumption off the licensed premises, and sell related
8 merchandise; and generally relating to the privileges of alcoholic beverages and
9 distillery licenses.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

18 2–202.

19 A Class 1 manufacturer’s license:

20 (1) Is a distillery license;

21 (2) Authorizes the:

22 (i) Establishment and operation in this State of a plant for
23 distilling brandy, rum, whiskey, alcohol and neutral spirits;

1 (ii) Sale and delivery of those alcoholic beverages in bulk to
2 persons authorized in this State to acquire them; and

3 (iii) Sale and delivery of those alcoholic beverages to persons
4 located outside this State;

5 (3) Shall be obtained for each trade name and for each distillery in
6 this State;

7 (4) Permits a distiller to manufacture alcoholic beverages in the name
8 of another person or under a trade name, provided a distillery license has been issued
9 to that other person or under that trade name, as the case may be; [and]

10 (5) Permits the holder of [such a] **THE** license to acquire bulk alcoholic
11 beverages from the holder of a distillery, rectifying, or winery license in this State or
12 from the holder of a nonresident dealer's permit; **AND**

13 **(6) PERMITS THE HOLDER OF THE LICENSE TO:**

14 **(I) CONDUCT GUIDED TOURS OF THE LICENSED PREMISES;**

15 **(II) SERVE NOT MORE THAN THREE SAMPLES OF PRODUCTS**
16 **MANUFACTURED AT THE LICENSED PREMISES, WITH EACH SAMPLE CONSISTING**
17 **OF NOT MORE THAN ONE-HALF OUNCE FROM A SINGLE PRODUCT, TO PERSONS**
18 **WHO HAVE ATTAINED THE LEGAL DRINKING AGE AND PARTICIPATED IN A**
19 **GUIDED TOUR OF THE LICENSED PREMISES;**

20 **(III) SELL OR SERVE:**

21 **1. NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES;**

22 **2. BREAD AND OTHER BAKED GOODS;**

23 **3. CHILI;**

24 **4. CHOCOLATE;**

25 **5. CRACKERS;**

26 **6. CURED MEAT;**

27 **7. FRUITS (WHOLE AND CUT);**

- 1 8. **SALADS AND VEGETABLES (WHOLE AND CUT);**
- 2 9. **HARD AND SOFT CHEESE (WHOLE AND CUT);**
- 3 10. **ICE CREAM;**
- 4 11. **JELLY AND JAM;**
- 5 12. **VINEGAR;**
- 6 13. **PIZZA;**
- 7 14. **PREPACKAGED SANDWICHES AND OTHER**
8 **PREPACKAGED FOODS READY TO BE EATEN;**
- 9 15. **SOUP; AND**
- 10 16. **CONDIMENTS; AND**

11 **(IV) SELL NOT MORE THAN THREE 750-MILLILITER**
12 **BOTTLES OF PRODUCTS MANUFACTURED ON THE LICENSED PREMISES, FOR**
13 **CONSUMPTION OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES, AND RELATED MERCHANDISE TO**
14 **PERSONS WHO HAVE ATTAINED THE LEGAL DRINKING AGE AND PARTICIPATED**
15 **IN A GUIDED TOUR OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 July 1, 2012.
