1 AN ACT concerning

Medical Laboratories – Laboratory Test and Clinical Laboratory Fees – Schedule

FOR the purpose of requiring a certain licensed medical laboratory to produce a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ certain fee schedule that includes certain information; requiring a certain fee 6 schedule to be regularly updated to provide certain information; requiring a 7 certain fee schedule and any supplemental materials to be published in certain 8 formats; requiring a medical laboratory to provide a certain fee schedule and 9 supplemental materials to a licensed physician on request of the physician; and generally relating to a fee schedule for medical laboratory tests and clinical 10 laboratory fees. 11

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(A) (1) A MEDICAL LABORATORY LICENSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE
SHALL PRODUCE A COMPREHENSIVE FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL THE LABORATORY
TESTS PERFORMED AND CLINICAL LABORATORY FEES CHARGED BY THE
MEDICAL LABORATORY.

1 (2) A FEE SCHEDULE PRODUCED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 2 SUBSECTION SHALL BE REGULARLY UPDATED TO PROVIDE THE MOST 3 ACCURATE INFORMATION ON THE LABORATORY TESTS PERFORMED, THE COSTS 4 OF THE LABORATORY TESTS PERFORMED, AND THE CLINICAL LABORATORY 5 FEES CHARGED BY THE MEDICAL LABORATORY.

6 (B) THE FEE SCHEDULE AND ANY SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS 7 PRODUCED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE IN BOTH A 8 PRINTED AND AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT.

9 (C) A MEDICAL LABORATORY SHALL PROVIDE THE FEE SCHEDULE AND 10 ANY SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS PRODUCED UNDER THIS SECTION TO A 11 LICENSED PHYSICIAN ON REQUEST OF THE PHYSICIAN.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2012.
