- 1 (a) (1) In consultation with the Oyster Advisory Commission AND SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the Department shall identify by regulation the public shellfish fishery area in the Chesapeake Bay based on commercial harvesting activity during the 3 years preceding June 1, 2009, any surveys conducted by the Department, and other quantitative data known or made available to the Department.
 - (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AS PART OF THE PUBLIC SHELLFISH FISHERY AREA ANY AREA WHERE A BIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE DENSITY OF OYSTERS IS AT LEAST ONE OYSTER THAT MEASURES 1 INCH OR MORE FROM HINGE TO BILL PER ACRE.
- 11 (b) The public shellfish fishery area may not be leased for shellfish 12 aquaculture.
