- 17 Except as provided under [subsection (b)] SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (D) of 18 this section, the Department shall collect county transfer tax at the rate set by each 19 county for articles of transfer, articles of consolidation, or articles of merger filed with 20 the Department as required by § 3-107, § 4A-703, § 9A-903, or § 10-208 of the 21 Corporations and Associations Article, or other document filed with the clerk of the 22 circuit court of a county or the Department which evidences a merger or consolidation 23of foreign corporations, foreign limited liability companies, foreign partnerships, or foreign limited partnerships. 24
