AN ACT concerning
Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages License - Repeal of Voter Registration Requirement for Licensees
FOR the purpose of repealing, as to Baltimore City, the requirement that as authorized person of a limited liability company who holds an alcoholic beverages license that was issued granted on or before a certain date be registered voter in the City; and generally relating to alcoholic beverage licenses in Baltimore City.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages Section 9–101(c)(1) Annotated Code of Maryland (2011 Replacement Volume)
