- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SPECIAL FUND" MEANS A FUND ESTABLISHED BY LAW TO BENEFIT OR EXPAND AN INDUSTRY IN THE STATE.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before January 1, 2013, the Treasurer, in consultation with the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs, shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on any special funds that are not in compliance with this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2012.
