SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings
5-106.
(BB) THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE PROSECUTION OF THE CRIME OF SOLICITATION IS THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE PROSECUTION OF THE SUBSTANTIVE CRIME THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE SOLICITATION.
