A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Occupations – Licensed Podiatrists – Scope of Practice**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “practice podiatry” to include the surgical
4 treatment of acute ankle fracture in the scope of practice of licensed podiatrists;
5 and generally relating to licensed podiatrists.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Health Occupations**

14 16–101.

15 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

16 (b) “Board” means the State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners.

17 (c) “License” means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued
18 by the Board to practice podiatry.

19 (d) “Licensed podiatrist” means, unless the context requires otherwise, a
20 podiatrist who is licensed by the Board to practice podiatry.

21 (e) “Podiatrist” means an individual who practices podiatry.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (f) (1) “Practice podiatry” means to diagnose or surgically, medically, or
2 mechanically treat the human foot or ankle, the anatomical structures that attach to
3 the human foot, or the soft tissue below the mid-calf.

4 (2) “Practice podiatry” does not include[:

5 (i) Surgical treatment of acute ankle fracture; or

6 (ii) Administration] **ADMINISTRATION** of an anesthetic, other
7 than a local anesthetic.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2012.
