15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **(B) EACH GOVERNING BOARD SHALL DEVELOP A POLICY FOR THE**
4 **WAIVER OF TUITION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMISSION AND THEIR**
