## A BILL ENTITLED

2	Dedicated Funds – Prohibition of Transfer
3 4 5 6 7 8	FOR the purpose of proposing an amendment to the Maryland Constitution prohibiting certain transfers of dedicated State funds to the General Fund except under certain circumstances; authorizing the General Assembly to transfer certain funds under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State for their adoption or rejection.

- Section 53
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, (Three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses concurring), That it be proposed that the Maryland Constitution read as follows:

## Article III - Legislative Department

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- 17 IN THIS SECTION, "DEDICATED STATE **FUNDS'' MEANS** (A) **(1)** COLLECTED STATE 18 REVENUES  $\mathbf{BY}$ THE THAT ARE **DEDICATED** OR CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED BY LAW TO A SPECIFIC PURPOSE. 19
- 20 (2) "DEDICATED STATE FUNDS" DOES NOT INCLUDE FUNDS 21 RECEIVED FROM THE STATE LOTTERY OR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
- 22 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, 23 DEDICATED STATE FUNDS MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES



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- 1 THAT ARE SET FORTH IN LAW AND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 3 (C) (1) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY USE DEDICATED STATE FUNDS 4 FOR A PURPOSE DIFFERENT FROM THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE FUNDS WERE 5 DEDICATED IF:
- 6 (I) THE GOVERNOR DECLARES AN EMERGENCY;
- 7 (II) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, BY LAW, ALTERS THE 8 PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE DEDICATED STATE FUNDS MAY BE USED; OR
- 9 (III) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, BY LAW, IN RESPONSE TO A 10 REALIZED SAVINGS, TRANSFERS THE DEDICATED STATE FUNDS IN AN EQUAL 11 PROPORTION AMONG OTHER STATE FUNDS.
- 12 **(2)** THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, BY LAW, MAY REPEAL A 13 DEDICATED STATE FUND AND TRANSFER THE FUNDS TO ANOTHER FUND OR 14 ACCOUNT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the General Assembly determines that the amendment to the Maryland Constitution proposed by this Act affects multiple jurisdictions and that the provisions of Article XIV, § 1 of the Maryland Constitution concerning local approval of constitutional amendments do not apply.
  - SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the aforegoing section proposed as an amendment to the Maryland Constitution shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the State at the next general election to be held in November, 2012 for their adoption or rejection pursuant to Article XIV of the Maryland Constitution. At that general election, the vote on this proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be by ballot, and upon each ballot there shall be printed the words "For the Constitutional Amendment" and "Against the Constitutional Amendment," as now provided by law. Immediately after the election, all returns shall be made to the Governor of the vote for and against the proposed amendment, as directed by Article XIV of the Maryland Constitution, and further proceedings had in accordance with Article XIV.
