A BILL ENTITLED

Public Service Commission – Application for Substantial Influence – **Divestiture of Gas and Electric Company**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Public Service Commission from approving a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ certain application that requests authorization to acquire the power to exercise 6 substantial influence over the policies and actions of a certain gas and electric 7 company unless the Commission requires a certain condition in a certain order 8 under a certain case; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally 9 relating to divestiture of a gas and electric company.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That the Public Service Commission may not approve an application filed by Exelon Corporation, Constellation Energy Group, Inc., and Baltimore Gas and 12 Electric Company that, in accordance with § 6-105 of the Public Utilities Article, 13requests authorization for Exelon Corporation to acquire the power to exercise 1415substantial influence over the policies and actions of Baltimore Gas and Electric 16 Company unless the Public Service Commission requires, as a condition of approval in 17an order under Case No. 9271 or any related or subsequent case, the resulting 18 company to divest itself of Baltimore Gas and Electric Company.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 19 20measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, 21has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 22elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from 23the date it is enacted.
