- FOR the purpose of terminating the Maryland Foaled Stakes Program; specifying that 4 certain money be allocated only to the Maryland Sire Stakes Program; 5 6 specifying that the Maryland Standardbred Race Fund consists only of the Sire 7 Stakes Program; repealing a requirement that the Maryland Racing Commission set a certain breeder's award under certain circumstances; 8 9 establishing a breeder's award for certain horses under a certain program; providing for the distribution of certain breeder's awards to certain horses 10 11 under certain circumstances; providing for a delayed effective date; making 12 certain technical changes; and generally relating to horse racing in the State.
