17 (b) (1) For fiscal year [2009] **2013** and each fiscal year thereafter, the 18 Administration shall separately recover from fares and other operating revenues at 19 least [35] **50** percent of the total operating costs for:

- 20 (i) The Administration's bus, light rail, and Metro subway 21 services in the Baltimore region; and
- (ii) All passenger railroad services under the Administration'scontrol.
