## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning
Motor Vehicles - Registration Plates - "Home of Our National Anthem"
FOR the purpose of requiring that certain registration plates for a vehicle display the words "Home of Our National Anthem"; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to requirements for registration plates.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Transportation
Section 13-410(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

13-410.
(b) (1) Each registration plate shall display:
(i) The registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; [and]
(ii) The name of this State, which may be abbreviated; AND
(III) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE WORDS "HOME OF OUR NATIONAL ANTHEM".
(2) The registration number may consist of letters, numerals, or both.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.
(3) PARAGRAPH (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER § 13-618, § 13-619, § 13-619.1, OR § 13-619.2 OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to registration plates manufactured on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
