16	(a) A person may not commit or attempt to commit robbery under § 3–402 of
17	this subtitle:
18	(1) with a dangerous weapon; [or]
19	(2) by displaying a written instrument claiming that the person has
20	possession of a dangerous weapon; OR
21	(3) BY MAKING AN ORAL CLAIM THAT THE PERSON HAS
22	POSSESSION OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON.



- 1 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 20 years.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2012.
