- 1 (B) (1) "BAY TMDL" MEANS THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD
 2 (TMDL) FOR THE CHESAPEAKE BAY ESTABLISHED UNDER THE FEDERAL
 3 CLEAN WATER ACT BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ON
 4 DECEMBER 29, 2010.
- 5 (2) "BAY TMDL" INCLUDES ANY MODIFICATIONS TO THE BAY 6 TMDL MADE BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.
- 7 (C) "BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE" MEANS A CONSERVATION OR 8 POLLUTION CONTROL PRACTICE THAT REDUCES THE LOAD OF POLLUTANTS 9 DISCHARGED INTO THE SURFACE WATERS OF THE STATE, INCLUDING 10 SEDIMENT, NITROGEN, AND PHOSPHORUS.
- 11 (D) (1) "WIP" MEANS A STATE WATERSHED IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (WIP) APPROVED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO 13 IMPLEMENT THE BAY TMDL WITHIN THE STATE.
- 14 (2) "WIP" INCLUDES ANY MODIFICATIONS TO A WIP MADE BY 15 THE STATE.

- 17 (A) (1) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2012, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
 18 DEVELOP A LIST OF THE BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES THAT A COUNTY MAY
 19 USE UNDER A WIP TO IMPLEMENT THE BAY TMDL.
- 20 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL RANK THE BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES ON THE LIST BASED ON THE COST AND EXPECTED POLLUTION REDUCTION VALUE OF EACH PRACTICE.
- 23 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION IN THE 24 LIST RELATING TO THE COMBINATIONS OF BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES 25 THAT MAXIMIZE POLLUTION REDUCTION AND MINIMIZE COST.
- 26 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL UPDATE THE LIST ANNUALLY.
- 27 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH THE LIST REQUIRED UNDER 28 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEB SITE AND MAIL 29 A HARD COPY OF THE LIST TO EACH COUNTY.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 June 1, 2012.
