24	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF			
25	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 (b) (1) For fiscal year 2009 and each fiscal year thereafter, the 3 Administration shall separately recover from fares and other operating revenues at
- 4 least 35 percent of the total operating costs for:
- 5 (i) The Administration's bus, light rail, and Metro subway 6 services in the Baltimore region; and
- 7 (ii) All passenger railroad services under the Administration's 8 control.
- 9 (B-2) (1) IF THE RECOVERY FROM FARES AND OPERATING REVENUES
  10 FOR TRANSIT SERVICES IN A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IS LESS THAN 35 PERCENT
  11 OF THE TOTAL OPERATING COSTS FOR TRANSIT SERVICES IN THE POLITICAL
  12 SUBDIVISION, THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL REMIT TO THE STATE THE
  13 DIFFERENCE BETWEEN:
- 14 (I) 35 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL OPERATING COSTS FOR 15 TRANSIT SERVICES IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION; AND
- 16 (II) THE RECOVERY FROM FARES AND OPERATING 17 REVENUES FOR TRANSIT SERVICES IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
- 18 (2) FOR TRANSIT SERVICES THAT ARE PROVIDED BY MEANS OF A
  19 TRANSIT FACILITY THAT EXTENDS ACROSS MORE THAN ONE POLITICAL
  20 SUBDIVISION, ANY REMITTANCE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE
  21 APPORTIONED AMONG THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN SHARES THAT ARE
  22 PROPORTIONAL TO THE LENGTH OF THE TRANSIT FACILITY SEGMENT WITHIN
  23 EACH POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
