# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Vehicle Laws – Historic Motor Vehicles

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying the types of motor vehicles that are eligible for 4 registration as historic motor vehicles; increasing the age that a motor vehicle  $\mathbf{5}$ must attain before it may be registered as a historic motor vehicle; prohibiting 6 certain historic motor vehicles from being used for certain purposes; requiring 7 an applicant for registration of a historic motor vehicle to submit with the 8 application a certification that the vehicle is insured by a certain vehicle 9 insurance policy; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to historic motor vehicles. 10

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Transportation

19 13–936.

20In this section, "historic motor vehicle" means a [motor vehicle, including (a) 21a passenger vehicle, motorcycle, or truck] CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE, CLASS 22D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE, CLASS Ε (TRUCK) VEHICLE. WITH Α 23MANUFACTURER'S GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF 10,000 POUNDS OR 24LESS, AND CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE, EXCLUDING A MOTOR HOME, 25that:

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (1)Is at least [20] 25 years old;  $\mathbf{2}$ Has not been substantially altered from the manufacturer's (2)3 original design; and 4 (3)Meets criteria contained in regulations adopted by the  $\mathbf{5}$ Administration. In this section, "historic motor vehicle" does not include a vehicle that has 6 (b)7 been remanufactured or reconstructed as a replica of an original vehicle. 8 If registered with the Administration under this section, every historic (c) 9 motor vehicle is a Class L (historic) vehicle. 10 Except as provided in subsection (i) of this section, for each Class L (d) (historic) vehicle, the annual registration fee is \$25.50. 11 12A HISTORIC MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS (e) (1) 13SECTION MAY NOT BE USED: **(I)** FOR GENERAL DAILY TRANSPORTATION; OR 14**(II)** PRIMARILY 15FOR THE **TRANSPORTATION** OF 16 PASSENGERS OR PROPERTY ON HIGHWAYS. 17(2) In applying for registration of a historic motor vehicle under this 18section, the owner of the vehicle shall submit with the application a certification that the vehicle for which the application is made: 1920Will be maintained for use in exhibitions, club activities, **[**(1)**] (I)** 21parades, tours, [occasional transportation,] and similar uses; [and 22(2) Will not be used: **(II)** 23(i) 1. For general daily transportation; or 24[(ii)] **2.** Primarily for the transportation of passengers or property on highways; AND 2526(III) IS INSURED BY A HISTORIC VEHICLE, SHOW VEHICLE, 27**OR ANTIQUE VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICY.** 

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1 (f) Except as provided in § 13–936.1 of this subtitle, on registration of a 2 vehicle under this section, the Administration shall issue a special, historic motor 3 vehicle registration plate of the size and design that the Administration determines.

4 (g) Unless the presence of the equipment was specifically required by a 5 statute of this State as a condition of sale when the vehicle was manufactured, the 6 presence of any specific equipment is not required for the operation of a vehicle 7 registered under this section.

8 (h) A vehicle registered under this section is exempt from any statute that 9 requires periodic vehicle inspections or that requires the use and inspection of 10 emission controls.

11 (i) (1) For a motor vehicle manufactured at least 60 years prior to the 12 current model year, there is a onetime registration fee of \$50.00.

13 (2) Registration of a motor vehicle manufactured under this subsection14 is not transferable to a subsequent owner.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2012.
