7 8 9	WHEREAS, The process for waiving the maintenance of effort requirement was established in 1996 and no county applied for a waiver under that process until fiscal year 2010; and
10 11 12	WHEREAS, When the maintenance of effort waiver process was used for the first time in fiscal year 2010, significant policy issues were identified regarding the appropriate penalty for not meeting the maintenance of effort requirement; and
13 14	WHEREAS, Legislation addressing the significant policy issues regarding the appropriate penalty has not been enacted; now, therefore,
15 16 17 18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the penalty provision under § 5–213(b)(3)(ii) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland may not be applied to State aid increase provided in fiscal year 2012 under § 5–202 of the Education Article.
