16 (A) (1) THE BUFFER STANDARDS UNDER COMAR 27.01.09.01E.(7)
17 DO NOT APPLY IN COUNTIES IN WHICH MORE THAN 50% OF THE SOIL CONSISTS
18 OF HYDRIC SOILS.

19 (2) THE PERCENTAGE OF HYDRIC SOIL IN A COUNTY IS 20EQUIVALENT TO THE AMOUNT OF HYDRIC SOIL STATED FOR THAT COUNTY IN 21THE CURRENT NATIONAL COOPERATIVE SOIL SURVEY BY THE UNITED STATES 22DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE. IN COOPERATION WITH THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION. 23
