Receipt of State Funds - Local Employee Requirement

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt regulations to 4 require that at least a certain percent of the employees of any recipient of State 5 funds are residents of the State; requiring the Board to adopt regulations to 6 provide that if a contract with the State is to be performed at a certain location 7 that at least a certain percent of the employees of the contractor reside within a 8 certain radius of the location; requiring a unit of State government, when using 9 competitive sealed bidding, to give a preference to a resident bidder if at least a certain percent of the employees of the resident bidder are residents of the 10 State; and generally relating to a requirement that at least a certain percent of 11 12 the employees of recipients of State funds be residents of the State.

- 22 (C) (1) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE THAT
- 23 AT LEAST 50% OF THE EMPLOYEES OF ANY RECIPIENT OF STATE FUNDS ARE
