- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring authorizing the State Highway Administration 5 Maryland Department of Transportation to use the maximum amount of certain federal funds available under a certain provision of federal law for highway or 6 7 <u>capital transit</u> construction training and supportive services, including skill 8 improvement programs; requiring the Department to administer certain 9 highway construction and supportive services programs in collaboration with 10 the Governor's Workforce Investment Board for a certain purpose; requiring the Administration Department and the Board to submit a certain report by a 11 12 certain date each year to certain committees of the General Assembly; requiring the report to include certain information; and generally relating to the use of 13 federal funds for highway or capital transit construction training. 14

- The purpose of this subtitle is to assist the national recovery and promote the general welfare by enabling this State and its political subdivisions to provide matching funds for and secure the benefits of any federal funds available under the federal acts for the construction and reconstruction of State highways and county roads and for related State or local projects.
