- 15 (a) In this section, "farm truck" means a farm vehicle that:
- 16 (1) Is a Class E (truck) vehicle; and
- 17 (2) Has a shipping weight of its chassis and battery, as certified by the 18 manufacturer, of more than 3/4 ton.
- 19 (b) On application, the Administration shall issue a Class E "farm truck 20 registration" to any applicant who certifies:

- (1) That the applicant is a farmer; and
