- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an insurance producer who is licensed to sell health 5 insurance to charge reasonable fees for services related to the administration of 6 a health benefit plan an administrative service that is sold by the insurance 7 producer to an employer and covers eligible employees of the employer; 8 providing that fees may not be charged by an insurance producer for certain 9 services; requiring an insurance producer to disclose certain information on a 10 certain form and in a certain manner before a fee for administrative services is 11 charged; requiring the disclosure form to be signed by the insurance producer 12 and an authorized representative of the employer and retained by the insurance producer as required by regulations adopted by the Maryland Insurance 13 14 Commissioner; defining certain terms; and generally relating to fees for administrative services provided by insurance producers. 15
