4 FOR the purpose of requiring each public institution of higher education ~~and State~~
5 ~~employment facility to develop on or before a certain date a facility master plan,~~
6 when it revises its facility master plan, to address bicycle and pedestrian
7 circulation on and around the institution's campus; requiring the institution ~~or~~
8 ~~employment facility~~ to include certain measures in the facility master plan; and
9 generally relating to bicycle and pedestrian access at institutions of higher
10 education ~~and State employment facilities.~~

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

19 21–1008.

1 (A) By fiscal year 2000, each public institution of higher education and State
2 employment facility shall provide reasonable accommodations necessary for bicycle
3 access, including parking for bicycles.

4 (B) ~~BY FISCAL YEAR 2014, EACH~~ WHEN A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF
5 HIGHER EDUCATION REVISES ITS FACILITY MASTER PLAN, THE PUBLIC
6 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND STATE EMPLOYMENT FACILITY
7 SHALL DEVELOP A FACILITY MASTER PLAN THAT ADDRESSES ADDRESS BICYCLE
8 AND PEDESTRIAN TRANSPORTATION CIRCULATION:

9 (1) ~~BETWEEN THE INSTITUTION OR EMPLOYMENT FACILITY AND~~
10 ~~THE COMMUNITIES ADJACENT TO THE INSTITUTION OR EMPLOYMENT FACILITY;~~
11 AND

12 (2) ~~WITHIN THE CAMPUS OF THE INSTITUTION OR EMPLOYMENT~~
13 ~~FACILITY.~~

14 (C) THE FACILITY MASTER PLAN SHALL INCLUDE MEASURES THAT THE
15 INSTITUTION ~~OR EMPLOYMENT FACILITY~~ PROPOSES TO:

16 (1) INCORPORATE BIKEWAYS AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES ON
17 THE CAMPUS; AND

18 (2) PROMOTE BIKING AND WALKING ON THE CAMPUS.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2012.
